

**VILLAGE OF DAVIS  
BOARD MEETING MINUTES OF  
MARCH 10, 2026**

President Olson brought the meeting to order at 7:00 PM in the Village Municipal Building with roll call. The following members were present: Mike Wise, Greg Price, Judy LaFurge, Kim Satness, Brittney Kunz, Becky Wise, and Jodie Pieper. The only one not present was Chelsey Scheid. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the Consent Agenda consisting of the minutes of the February meeting, Treasurer's Report, bills to be paid, and the late utility list was discussed. An invoice from Autumn Supply for \$264.80 was added to be paid. Jody made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda, with the added invoice, and Becky seconded – carried.

A representative from Central Cable Company attended and explained that his company is installing fiber optics for high-speed internet in small towns and rural areas. They are doing the actual work for Silo Communications and have installed fiber in Rockton areas already. He explained the process they follow and answered questions from the board. He said to install the fiber in the village would take about two weeks and if granted permission they would likely start work in June. Residents would have 100% option to hook up to the service and there would be no cost at all to the village. No decision was made to give time to do further research and it will be discussed next month.

Due to multiple scheduling conflicts, the April meeting will be changed from Tuesday, 4/14/26 to Wednesday, 4/22/26 with a motion to do so from Becky and second from Judy – carried.

There will be a Dart Tournament fundraiser at PJ's Corner Tap on March 28<sup>th</sup> to raise money for Davis Town and Country.
