

PUBLIC NOTICE
WATERMAIN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The Village of Davis has begun construction of the Watermain Improvements Project located on Primrose Lane from Salisbury St. to Snyder St., Snyder Street from Primrose Ln. to the alley West of Marsh St. and Marsh St. to Wright St., Alley West of Marsh Street from Eply St. to Snyder St., Wright Street from Snyder St. to Webb St., and Webb Street from Wright St. to East St. This project includes approximately 2,713 feet of 6" and 8" diameter watermain and new water services, fire hydrants, and mainline valves complete with all necessary appurtenances and surface restoration. The project is being financed by the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SRF). The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Once complete, this project will allow the Village to continue to provide quality drinking water for area residents and businesses and will replace aging and deteriorating watermains. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities with the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.
